MAISRC Update In Detroit Lakes June 9

A group of Lake Coalitions and county agencies are hosting a Minnesota Aquatic Invasive Species Research Center ([MAISRC](#)) Update at the M-State Campus in Detroit Lakes, MN on June 9, 2022. Speakers from the University of Minnesota Aquatic Invasive Research Center, Dan Larkin and Meg Duhr, will offer the latest on combating such invasive species as zebra mussels and starry stonewort. Jeff Forester of Minnesota Lakes and Rivers Advocates ([MLR](#)) will give the latest update on legislation affecting Minnesota lakes. Tables for distribution of information will be present.
